Sub: JNTUH-Conduct of CBT or equivalent exam to improve internal marks - for the candidates who have completed their course work but not passed in the semester exams due to very low internal marks – Reg.

Read 1) SCAS Item 2 of 52nd Meeting of the Executive Council, dated 06-05-2020.
2) U.O. Note No. RP/EC-52/2020/, dtd. 29.05.2020 of the Registrar, JNTUH.

ORDER:

The University Executive Council vide (2)read above, approved to conduct a CBT or equivalent exam to improve internal marks of the candidates who have completed their course work but did not pass one or more subjects in the semester examinations due to very low/zero internal marks. The additional rules are as follows:

- It is proposed to conduct a CBT or equivalent exam for the candidates who secured internal marks less than a specified mark and could not pass one or more subjects due to low internal marks. One-time chance of supplementary end-semester examinations shall be conducted for all these candidates after the CBT or equivalent exam.
- The students who have completed all semesters of their B.Tech./B.Pharm. course work can only avail this option.
- This option shall be extended up to double the duration of course period, counted from the year of admission and for those who are eligible for one time chance.
- For all the students who completed the duration of the course period, counted from the year of admission and for those who are eligible for one time chance shall be given one chance to appear for the CBT/equivalent exam to improve their internal marks.

These orders shall come into force with immediate effect.
