NORMS OF MID TERM EXAMINATION

- The mid examination is scheduled for a duration of 1 hour 20 minutes.
- The duration of subjective type paper is 1hr.
- The duration of objective type paper is 20 minutes.
- After taking back the Answered subjective type papers, objective type question paper shall be given.
- The objective type question paper is to be supplied to the students during the last 20 minutes of the examination.
- The objective type question paper will be supplied by JNTUH in 4 sets and the papers must be distributed in EAMCET Pattern.

FORMAT OF QUESTION PAPER (B.Tech.)

- 1. Subjective type question paper shall contain 4 (Four) questions and shall be set for a maximum of 10 marks.
- 2. Each question shall carry 5 (Five) marks.
- 3. If required, questions can be set as (a) and (b) parts. The marks against each part shall be mentioned clearly.
- 4. Students have to answer 2 (Two) questions out of 4 (Four) questions given.
- 5. All 4 (Four) questions shall be chosen from the units suggested by JNTUH.
- 6. HODs shall ensure that questions are given from the units specified by JNTUH.
- 7. Objective type question paper carries 10 marks and will be supplied by JNTUH.

NORMS OF ASSIGNMENT

- 1. Assignments are made mandatory by JNTUH
- 2. There shall be 2 assignments in a semester
